


# Waddington Redwood Primary Academy

Dear Parent/Carers,

I am writing to inform you about all of our exciting plans for World Book Day on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2019. This year's theme is 'Share a Story' so a large part of our day will involve the children sharing their favourite books with their friends, teachers and you! At the start of the day, we are inviting all parents and carers to join us in school for a special Share a Story Morning. We hope that many of you will be able to join your children in class to share in a love of reading. A separate correspondence giving more details about the morning will follow closer to the time.

We are inviting children to come to school dressed as their favourite character from a book and ask for a charitable donation of £1 for dressing up. This will go to the World Book Day charity – Book Aid International, who send books to disadvantaged children around the world. Children may also wish to bring their favourite book with them to share with their class. There are many easy to make costume ideas available on the World Book Day Website.

By popular demand, I will be holding a Harry Potter Book Club every lunchtime over the course of the week commencing Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March 2019. Children will have the opportunity to sign up for this in school. We have also invited a Scholastic Book Fair to join us in school on 29<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

Finally, after the success of last year, we will also be holding another Book Swap Shop, which children will have the opportunity to visit over the course of the day. If children would like to participate in the Book Swap, we are asking that they bring up to 5 books into school that they have already read and would like to swap for something new. **The books must be appropriate for their current age group.** Children will then be given tokens to exchange at the Swap Shop for new books to take home and discover.

We ask that children bring all books into school before Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> March and give them, along with this slip, to their class teacher.
