### Ambassador Voice:

We have come to the end of our first term in our role. We would like to share with you what we have done so far this year! As a result of the feedback that we received from the parent and pupil questionnaires last year, we will share this information in the form of a newsletter.

This term we have started our important work in school. We have introduced ourselves to the rest of the pupils and have delivered Anti-Bullying Week and a whole school assembly.



### Below is a summary of our work carried out during the Autumn term:

- **Anti-Bullying Week:** *'Choose Respect'*. This year our theme for Anti-Bullying was 'Choose Respect'. During Anti-Bullying week, the whole school took part in many activities exploring the types, signs and impact bullying has. All classes also contributed art work to create a display 'What makes our school a happier place?' which will be completed ready for our new term in January.
- **Whole school assembly:** As part of our Anti-Bullying week and our Ambassador role we led a whole school assembly where we explored why we have Anti-Bullying Week and what we can do to help put a stop to bullying.
- **Wear Blue Day:** This term we held a 'Wear Blue Day' to help promote the work of the charity Bullying UK. We raised money for this charity alongside Children in Need. In total we raised £117.45 for Bullying UK.
- **Poster Competition:** This term, we held a poster competition in school. The children designed posters to help spread the 'Stop Bullying' message. We have looked through the entries from each class and we will display some of these around school.
- **Playground rota:** The Ambassadors continue to support both the KS1 and KS2 children at playtimes. The Ambassadors have a rota that they follow to ensure all children have access to an Ambassador when needed!
