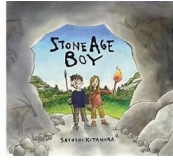

- Addition & Subtraction

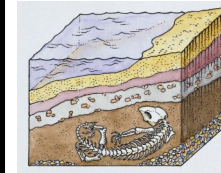
