


# UKS2 Autumn 2 Curriculum Bulletin Land of the Free

In **English**, we will be reading and writing:

- Non-chronological reports
- Narratives

We are reading the book Goodnight Mr Tom together.



This term in **History**, we will be learning about the causes of World War 2 and the countries involved in the war. We will learn about the

impact of the war on everyday life at home, including rationing, the Blitz and evacuation.



In **Religious Education**, the children will develop their understanding of Hinduism.



In **PSHE**, we will build upon our knowledge of Identity, society and equality.

In **Spanish**, we will be learning how to describe and converse about TV programmes, music and films we like and dislike.


This term in **Maths**, Year 5 will be learning about:

- Graphs and tables




This term in **Maths**, Year 6 will be learning about:

- Four Operations ( + - x ÷ )
- Fractions
- Geometry— position and direction.




In **Physical Education**, we will be developing our skills in netball and gymnastics.

This term in **Science**, we will be finishing our chemistry work on materials and their properties.
